Here are some ideas for modifying or adapting materials and activities to children with special needs. Encourage children with special needs to participate in art activities. Use appropriate ways to let children know what art materials are available.

Creative Art Activities for Children with Special Needs ...

During these activities the pupils have to learn to focus to the topic of the communication and with the help of the teacher try to shut out distractions. Social interactions in the breaks between lessons provide opportunity for the teaching assistant to build positive relationships with the pupils, but stay in a professional manner.

Teaching Assistant Materials

As the year begins, provide activities and books that are familiar from children's preschool days. Help the shy child assist you with activities such as getting materials ready for group time, or setting the table. This will help her feel comfortable. Make lots of personal contact with the child who jumps into activities.
