For the benefit of readers who aren't familiar, a merchant category code is a four-digit number the major credit card networks (Visa, Discover, American Express and Mastercard) assign to every business that applies to accept credit cards. The number corresponds to the type of business or service the company offers.

How to find a business's merchant category code ...

Issuer response test values. Input these magic values in: <cardHolderName> (Direct model) The Cardholder's name field on the test payment page (Hosted model). The results come back in <ISO8583ReturnCode>, and you can view them in: The test payment response (Direct) Notifications
