A total of 68 youth (50% female, 47% male, 3% transgender) participated in the focus groups (n = 63); some youth were unable to take part in the focus groups, but wanted to be included, so individual interviews were also conducted with 5 persons.Participants ranged in age from 14 to 24 with almost half indicating they were 16 or 17 years old.

### FACTORS INFLUENCING YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN DEVELOPMENT ...

Development in Traumatized Children and Youth. Healthy brain development is essential for realizing one's full potential and for overall well-being. ### Supporting Brain Development in Traumatized Children and Youth

Family-based approaches to treating adolescent substance abuse highlight the need to engage the family, including parents, siblings, and sometimes peers, in the adolescent's treatment. Involving the family can be particularly important, as the adolescent will often be living with at least one parent and be subject to the parent's controls, rules, and/or supports.
