Examples Of Stop Consonants "We may describe the first sound in pit as a voiceless bilabial stop (transcribed as [p]) . . . The consonant in abbey is also a bilabial stop, but differs from that in pit: it is voiced.This consonant (transcribed as [b]) is a voiced bilabial stop. "The first sound in tin is a voiceless alveolar stop; it is transcribed as [t].
