Normal, healthy pockets will typically be between 1 and 3 mm deep. Better brushing and flossing will usually be recommended for 3 mm pockets. - Before submitting a claim for SRP, check the company's guidelines on their Web site or in the provider office reference guide.
- When submitting SRP for more than 2 quadrants within a single visit, include documentation-mouth periodontal charting, FMX, —full periodontal diagnosis and the treatment plan.

### **D4341, D4342 CODING FOR PERIODONTAL SCALING AND ROOT ...**

Initial stage should be determined using clinical attachment loss (CAL). If CAL is not available, radiographic bone loss (RBL) should be used. Tooth loss due to periodontitis may modify stage definition. One or more complexity factors may shift the stage to a higher level.

### **Staging and Grading Periodontitis**

Established periodontal disease with 25–50% attachment loss. Appropriate care: Periodontal therapy\* including periodontal surgery will only be successful if the client is committed to consistently administering home dental care. Extraction indicated if client and patient will not commit to daily home oral hygiene.
